Dear Resident,

The Town of Bethel Public Works Department has completed repairs and installation of storm water drainage on ***Shelter Rock Road from Payne Road to Danbury town line*** in preparation for rebuilding of the road surface. The following schedule includes information that you will find useful during this process. Please be aware that the road will be closed daily to through traffic during our operations, although emergency and school bus traffic will not be interrupted. ***Lexington Meadows Residents will have access through Danbury via Plumtrees Road in Danbury. Included with this letter are three passes to present to police officers stationed at the intersection of Shelter Rock Road and Plumtrees Road so you can pass through to Lexington Meadows.*** Please drive carefully, as you may encounter short delays. The daily road closures assist us in providing a safe work zone for our employees and completion of the project in a timely manner.

The scope of this project will include a full depth reclamation of the bituminous surface and subgrade materials, grading and compaction of the reclaimed material, and the application of liquid calcium chloride. This will leave a loose gravel road surface for a short period of time. A two layer bituminous overlay will be installed over the gravel surface, followed by the installation of driveway aprons to match the new road surface. Curbing will only be installed in areas that are prone to erosion, and areas that cause water run off problems.

While the road is being prepared for the bituminous overlay, airborne dust from the gravel surface may occur. We will make every attempt to keep this occurrence at a minimum. You may encounter short delays while traveling on the road. Please keep in mind that the safety of our employees as well as the residents is our primary concern. We will work diligently to ensure that this project is completed in a timely manner, although conditions such as weather, equipment failures and schedules for contracted services can affect our proposed schedule.

1: Full Depth Reclamation	9/19/2016 thru 9/21/2016
2: Fine Grading and Compaction	9/19/2016 thru 9/21/2016
3: Bituminous Paving	9/22/2016 thru 9/26/2016
4: Driveway Aprons & Curbing	Approx. 20 days after paving
5: Final clean up, topsoil and seeding	Following Driveway Apron Installation

Scheduled dates may change to allow project completion prior to actual schedule
