The Commission came out of executive session at 9:09 p.m.



Further that such offer be extended to Mr. Michael McKinney, Mr. Jonathan McClintock and Mr. Gregory Emerson, in that order, conditional upon there being an opening within the next 90 days, subject to a background investigation and the same standard requirement of the State of Connecticut and Town of Bethel; seconded by Comm Rubino – unanimous.
