MINUTES

Motion made by D. Goodrich and seconded by K. Stevens to approve the minutes as presented. Motion passed unanimously.

Mrs. Settanni was present for the application. She would like to grade the rear portion of her property in order to gain access to it. She showed photos of her property and pointed out where she would like to do maintenance. Right now she is accessing the area through her sister’s driveway located at 147 Plumtrees Road. She plans on bringing in some fill to grade the area and stated that it would be less than 100 yards of fill that she would need.

Motion made by P. Perrefort and seconded by W. Michael to approve 145 Plumtrees Road, for filling of the property from the pipe under Plumtrees Road to 147 Plumtrees Road and to keep the fill being brought in to under 100 yards, if it becomes more than 100 yards of fill, the applicant needs to come back to the Commission with engineered drawings.
