- **Approval of the Sewer Allocations Program:**

First Selectman Knickerbocker made a motion, which was seconded by Selectman Szatkowski to approve the Proposed Sewer Allocation Program dated December 2012. Vote, All in Favor, Motion Approved.

- **48-50 Stony Hill Road:**

First Selectman Knickerbocker made a motion, seconded by Selectman Szatkowski to approve the application for 48 - 50 Stony Hill Road for sewer use which applies for this zone, subject to the mandatory waiting period without a challenge and to notify the Planning and Zoning Commission of the approval. Vote, All in Favor, Motion Approved.

- **37 Maple Ave; Affordable Housing Application:** Mr. Morosky indicated he spoke with the Town Planner regarding the status of the application for 37 Maple Ave. and suggests the Commission table this application until a later date.

First Selectman Knickerbocker made a motion, which was seconded by Selectman Straiton to Table 37 Maple Ave. Vote, All in Favor, Motion Approved.


- **82-84 Stony Hill Road:**
