COMMISSION MEMBERS PRESENT: Vice Chairman K. Stevens; C. Cuggino; P. Perrefort; D. O'Grady' and B. Cavagna, Inland Wetlands Agent.

Vice Chairman Stevens called the meeting to order at 7:04p.m. and stated that since he was absent from the last meeting he listened to the tapes.

PUBLIC HEARINGS CONTINUED:

TOWN OF BETHEL, PLUMTREES ROAD, BRIDGE REPLACEMENT

Andrew Morosky, Town Engineer was present. He handed in certification of notification to the surrounding neighbors for the record. Andrew explained that the application was previously approved by DEEP and DEP. They worked with them on where to install E&S Controls in order to keep sedimentation and stabilization. The largest machine that will be used is a backhoe. The project will take approximately 2 years to do. The old bridge will be removed and a new bridge will be installed. The new bridge will be wider and bigger and this is for the safety of traffic and pedestrians. He went over the mitigation and drainage plans. Four new drainages systems will be constructed. They will create rip rap and 2 new catch basins on Whittlesey Drive. Two basins will be on the west side of the bridge that will outlet to the downstream pipe. The first grid separator will be in front of where the deli was. The separators pull heavy material out of pipe so the water flows smooth. Permanent wetland impact will be filled in to facilitate the construction of the roadway. Those who spoke: Judy Novachek, 15 Pleasant Street. B. Cavagna asked if the invasive can be removed during this construction and replanting of a straight meadow grass replace them. Andrew said he had no problem removing the invasive. K. Stevens closed the public hearing.

MINUTES

CHARLES WAY, 26 GRASSY PLAIN STREET, REGULATED ACTIVITY

Motion made by K. Stevens and seconded by P. Perrefort to accept the application as complete and to schedule a public hearing for March 25, 2013 with referring the application out to staff. Motion passed unanimously.

RMS DEVELOPMENT, SITE PLAN/REGULATED ACTIVITY, 48-50 STONY HILL ROAD


After much discussion, it was the consensus of the commission that a resolution of approval is drawn up.
