MINUTES OF PUBLIC HEARING

PUBLIC COMMENTS:

Patrick Perrefort, Wooster Street questioned the debt service.

Barry Curina explained that debt service is a debt and not an operating expense. The majority of the debt service resulted from Bethel's portion of costs associated with the sewer treatment plant. This will be paid off in 2014.

A general discussion took place regarding the operation of the sewer department. It was pointed out that an additional 1200 users will be coming on in the future which will help offset the cost.
