The proposal is to extend the town sewer drainage approximately 50' in order to remove the owner's machines from behind the existing house. The applicant was before the commission 20 years ago and received an approval to extend the drainage but never started the project due to personal issues. Now he would like to clean up the back yard, but in order to do this, he must get rid of the old machines that are in the back through a safe access way. Goodrich continued the public hearing, at which time the applicant will hand in finalized plans. The commission is also waiting for a final review from the Town Engineer.
