**INLAND WETLANDS COMMISSION MEETINGS MINUTES
JUNE 22ND, 2009 – DENIS J. RIORDAN ROOM D
BETHEL MUNICIPAL CENTER – 7:00P.M.**

COMMISSION MEMBERS PRESENT: Chairman D. Goodrich, K. Stevens, P. Perrefort and B. Cavagna, Inland Wetlands Agent.

D. Goodrich called the meeting to order at 7:15p.m.

CAMPBELL, 47 NASHVILLE ROAD, SIGNIFICANT ACTIVITY

Before continuing the public hearing the applicant was informed that there were only three commissioners present and if the applicant wished to proceed. Mr. McCoy wanted to proceed with the public hearing and didn't have a problem with only three commissioners present.

John McCoy, P.E. was present. D. Goodrich noted a memo dated 6/19/09 from the Town Engineer based on the old plans. Mr. McCoy went over a revised plan that was recently handed in. There were a couple of changes that were made. No one spoke.

D. Goodrich closed the public hearing.

OAKRIDGE ROAD, SEWER PROJECT, TOWN OF BETHEL

Motion made by D. Goodrich and seconded by K. Stevens to approve Oakridge Road, Sewer Project, Town of Bethel with stipulations. In granting the approval, the Inland Wetlands Commission acknowledges that the permit is issued in accordance with the Bethel Inland Wetlands and Watercourses Regulations, and the application was considered under the standards and criteria for decision in Sec. 115-22. The permit is subject to all applicable sections of enforcement within the regulation (Note Section

115-28 A, B, C1, C2, and C3). The permit is also subject to compliance by the applicant with all other regulations, codes, ordinances and requirements of the Town of Bethel, Connecticut necessary to undertake the proposed activity. Motion passed unanimously.

Motion made by D. Goodrich and seconded by K. Stevens to add the following:

Town of Bethel, Stream Culvert, 127 Walnut Hill Road.

Motion passed unanimously.

B. Cavagna explained that currently the culvert is in need of repair and/or replacement. It is ready to collapse. The town is currently working on plans to fix the problem.

Motion made by D. Goodrich and seconded by K. Stevens to accept the application. Motion passed unanimously.

Motion made by D. Goodrich and seconded by K. Stevens to schedule a public hearing for July 27th, 2009. Motion passed unanimously.
