Water Utility Coordinating Committees are regional committees established, pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes (CGS) Section 25-33c through 25-33j, to coordinate the planning and orderly development of Connecticut's public drinking water systems and sources. Each WUCC consists of one representative from each public water system and one representative of each regional planning organization within the delineated management area. The Departments of Environmental Protection, Public Utility Control, and the Office of Policy and Management participate in the process, which is lead by the Department of Public Health.

Significant agenda items scheduled to be discussed at this meeting are:

- A request by the West Shore Owners Association to realign the exclusive service area (ESA) of United Water Company to exclude the West Shore Owners Association (WSOA). The property of the proposed WSOA is primarily in Middlebury (outside of the Housatonic WUCC) with a portion containing five homes within Woodbury and the ESA area of United Water Company.
- Request by Triple 3 Builders, LLC and Laurel View Associates, LLC to discuss what options and remedies are available regarding their application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity. This certificate project is within the exclusive service area of United Water Company and the complainants have alleged that this has resulted in numerous delays, misunderstandings, omissions, negligence, and unwarranted requests at a substantial cost over the last five plus years.
- Discussion of Rules and Procedures Sub-Committee Findings.
