

PARKS & RECREATION COMMISSION
MEETING, JUNE 30, 2010

The meeting of the Commission was called to order by chairman Meghan O'Connor at 7:35 p.m. In attendance were Gary Regan, Pat Morton, Lou Valenti, Angelo Franzese, Eileen Earle and Rachael McGrath.

Minutes of the previous meeting were accepted on a motion by Angelo Franzese, seconded by Gary Regan, unanimously approved by all members present.

There were no public comments.

Accounts Payable, Payroll and Income were accepted on a motion from Pat Morton, seconded by Gary Regan, unanimously approved by all members present.

There was no correspondence.

The following programs are complete: Body by Bethel, Ballet and Dance, Volleyball for Adults, Art classes, Preschool classes, Baseball, softball, lacrosse, soccer, volleyball camp, field hockey camp, lacrosse camp, softball camp. The following programs are in progress: Summer camp, Bethel's Men's basketball, tennis, art class and Zumba. The following programs are being planned: Tennis camp, football camp, Summer sports camps, Road race.

ROAR: Remote control car group is doing a good job of getting the area ready to start their season. Have been very helpful in the clean-up process.

RENTAL FEES: Discussed having a set plan for the next meeting, and adding \$25 for use of the lights.

Miscellaneous: Angelo Franzese on behalf of AYF Football asked if Park and Recreation could help out financially this year due to the amount of participants in need of full to partial scholarships. They have ordered new uniforms at a cost of \$32,000 and believe they may be short as much, but not more than \$10,000. Lou Valenti made a motion to have a one time donation of \$5,000 to help defray costs of the new uniforms in these challenging economic times. The motion was seconded by Gary Regan, unanimously approved by all members present, and Angelo Franzese abstained.

Lights for track were discussed, as well as the overall timeframe of the project. Lights have been approved with Musco on a lease to buy, with no payment till July of 2011. The ground breaking should be this Monday, July 5th and the goal is to have the project complete by September 23rd, 2010.

Ms. O'Connor indicated that the next meeting of the Commission will be held on August 25, 2010 at 7:30pm.

The motion for adjournment was made by Lou Valenti, seconded by Pat Morton, unanimously approved by all members.
