**INLAND WETLANDS COMMISSION MEETINGS MINUTES

Chairman Goodrich called the meeting to order at 7:05p.m.

**ECB REALITY INC., DECLARATORY RULING, 180 OLD HAWLEYVILLE ROAD**

Dunkin Donuts is proposing to move in next to Subway and are currently in front of the Planning & Zoning Commission. A letter from Dinaus Virbickas, PE was read into the record that stated there are no wetlands on the property. The closest wetlands are located 42' to the west of the property. They will not be working in or anywhere near the wetlands.

Motion made by D. Goodrich and seconded by P. Perrefort to issue a Declaratory Ruling for ECB Reality Inc., 180 Old Hawleyville Road. Motion passed unanimously.

**TOWN OF BETHEL MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR**

B. Cavagna passed out pictures showing the two major water areas on Bennett's property now have a mud and silt build up in the pond. It now looks like a peninsula. The town would like to come in and remove the small section to break it up so when it storms it doesn't back up. They will use a backhoe and a dump truck. The machine will not go into the water. There will be very little disturbance while doing this job.
