

PARKS & RECREATION COMMISSION
SPECIAL MEETING, FEBRUARY 24, 2010

The special meeting of the Commission was called to order by chairman Meghan O'Connor at 7:32 p.m. In attendance were Gary Regan, Pat Morton, Lou Valenti, Bill Pullan, Angelo Franzese, Rachael McGrath and Chad Klinefelter.

Minutes of the previous meeting were accepted on a motion by Gary Regan, seconded by Angelo Franzese, unanimously approved by all members present.

There were no public comments.

Accounts Payable, Payroll and Income were accepted on a motion from Pat Morton, seconded by Lou Valenti, unanimously approved by all members present.

There was no correspondence.

The following programs are complete: Learn to Skate. The following programs are in progress: Body by Bethel, Ballet and Dance, Volleyball for Adults, Art classes, Preschool classes, Tae Kwon Do, Karate, Afterschool Sports, Zumba, travel and intown basketball, high school basketball, over 40 basketball and ski trips. The following programs are being planned: Summer camp, sports camps.

Summer camp will be able to have the usual 6 week sessions, with the last week being restricted to the school cafeterias. A second week of Sansonetti tennis camp was discussed, and was decided that it would be better to have just the regular one week session.

Miscellaneous: A motion was made by Lou Valenti, seconded by Gary Regan, unanimously approved by all members present to create a comprehensive Capital improvement plan. This plan would outline in detail, giving both need and cost, what the priorities were to improve the current availability of fields and other recreational opportunity.

A motion was made by Lou Valenti, seconded by Bill Pullan, unanimously approved by all members present to look into the finances of all associations sponsored by Park and Recreation. It was suggested to look at the associations 990's.

Ms. O'Connor indicated that the next meeting of the Commission will be held on March 31, 2010 at 7:30pm.

The motion for adjournment was made by Pat Morton, seconded by Angelo Franzese, unanimously approved by all members.
