**INLAND WETLANDS COMMISSION
MEETINGS MINUTES
JANUARY 24TH, 2010 - DENIS J. RIORDAN ROOM D

COMMISSION MEMBERS PRESENT: Chairman D. Goodrich, G. Tiernan, R. Haas, and B. Cavagna, Inland Wetlands Agent.

Chairman Goodrich called the meeting to order at 7:20p.m.

NEW BUSINESS

PUBLIC HEARING:

TOWN OF BETHEL, 127 WALNUT HILL ROAD, POND DREDGE

Andrew Morosky, Town Engineer and Mrs. Piera were both present. Andrew pointed out the two ponds located to the west of Weed Road that were on the map. The commission went out on a site walk back in December and Andrew was able to show the original configurations. They are proposing to remove 1100 cubic yards of materials, once dried out they will relocate the material on the downstream outside of the floodplain. The floodplain will not be filled in. Silt fence will be installed prior to grading. Mr. Morosky pointed out the places where hay bales, barriers, and equipment staging area will be going. They will rebuild the spillways using the materials with concrete and put it back to working order. Wetland compatible plantings will be along the watercourse. B. Cavagna stated that they should start any work after March 1st. The best time to do work would be now or in August. Andrew agreed and said that they could start in August but wanted to see if they could some tree removal now. No one spoke. Chairman Goodrich closed the public hearing.

WORK SESSION


TOWN OF BETHEL, 127 WALNUT HILL ROAD, POND DREDGE
