

**NOTICE OF APPROVAL
TOWN OF BETHEL
Public Utilities Commission
Amendment to the Rules and Regulations
of the Sewer Department**

After publication and public hearing on April 4, 2011, the Public Utilities Commission of the Town of Bethel approved an amendment to the Rules and Regulations of the Sewer Department entitled "4.4 EXCEPTION TO EXPANSION PERMIT OUTSIDE SEWER SERVICE AREA." at its meeting of May 9, 2011. A copy of the same with the charges due under the amendment was filed in the office of the Bethel Town Clerk, Municipal Center, 1 School Street, Bethel, CT on May 27, 2011 to which reference may be had.

Pursuant to the amendment, those parties affected by said amendment and after approval by the Public Utilities Commission to expand sewer use outside the sewer service area shall pay all costs for the same and shall pay to the Town of Bethel, Public Utilities Commission the sum of Twelve Thousand Five Hundred (\$12,500.00) Dollars for each residential use expansion and Twenty Five Thousand (\$25,000.00) Dollars for each commercial use expansion.

Any party wishing to appeal the charges set forth by this amendment must do so within three weeks of the filing of the same with the Town Clerk of the Town of Bethel pursuant to Connecticut General Statute § 7-255.
