**COMMISSION MEMBERS PRESENT:** Chairman D. Goodrich; Vice Chairman K. Stevens; L. Ferguson; P. Perrefort; and Inland Wetlands Agent B. Cavagna.

Chairman Goodrich called the meeting to order at 6:34p.m.

**RMS DEVELOPMENT:**

Gerry, Site Supervisor; Vinny; and Doug DiVesta, P.E. was all present. Mr. DiVesta walked the commission around the site and showed where the gravel wetlands are. He pointed out where the outlet pipe will be replaced with twin 36" pipes. They will be taking out just the soft part of the pond which will be approximately 1200 to 1300 cubic yards. They will have a dewatering ring with hay bales and silt fence. A dry hydrant for the fire department will be installed at the far end near the club house. A walking path will go around the pond. Two 48" pipes will be coming out and into the pond. He walked to the back of the property and pointed out where the sand bag dam will go in when they dewater the pond. There will be a bio filter between the buildings and over top of it will be plantings and curb so vehicles cannot drive over top.

Motion made by D. Goodrich and seconded by K. Stevens to allow the pond dredging to begin on June 24, 2014. Motion passed unanimously.

**MINUTES**

D. Goodrich adjourned the meeting at 8:35p.m.
