- Computers, Cell phones, TV's (E-Waste) - **FREE WITH PROOF OF RESIDENCY**
- Leaves - **FREE WITH PROOF OF RESIDENCY - NO COMMERCIAL VEHICLES**
- Magazines and glossy catalogs
- Mattresses and Box Springs- **FREE**
- Metal and glass food and beverage containers - **MUST BE CLEAN**
- Newspapers with inserts – Paper Board
- Phone books – Junk Mail – Shredded Paper – **In Clear Bags**
- Plastic food and beverage containers 1 thru 7 - **MUST BE CLEAN**
- Scrap Metal – See Fee Schedule
- Used Appliances – See Fee Schedule
- Used Cooking Oil
- Used Motor Oil / Antifreeze / Oil Filters
