BULKY WASTE	FEES
Mattresses and Box Springs: The Town of Bethel has volunteered to participate in the Connecticut enacted Public Act 13-42, thereby giving our residents access to FREE recycling services for mattresses and box springs that are clean and dry . Any Mattress and Box Spring that does not meet the programs criteria will be subject to a fee.

Leaves by Carload; PROOF OF RESIDENCY ONLY	FREE
Trees and Brush Material by Carload	\$10 per car

- Corrugated Cardboard **ONLY** – **MUST BE DRY & CLEAN**
- Clothing & Textiles – **FREE** – **MUST BE DRY & CLEAN** – **Donation Box**
- Computers, Cell phones, TV's (E-Waste) - **FREE WITH PROOF OF RESIDENCY**
- Leaves – Loose or in Paper Bags
 - **FREE WITH PROOF OF RESIDENCY - NO COMMERCIAL VEHICLES**
- Magazines and glossy catalogs – **DRY & CLEAN**
- Metal food and beverage containers – **MUST BE CLEAN**
- Glass food and beverage containers - **MUST BE CLEAN**
 - **GLASS HAS ITS OWN CONTAINER**
- Newspapers with inserts – Paper Board – Paperback Books – Junk Mail - **MUST BE DRY & CLEAN**
- Shredded Paper – **EMPTY INTO TOTERS**
- Plastic food and beverage containers **1 thru 7** - **MUST BE DRY & CLEAN**
- Scrap Metal – See Fee Schedule
- Used Appliances – See Fee Schedule
- Used Cooking Oil
- Used Motor Oil / Antifreeze / Oil Filters
- Pizza Boxes – **MUST BE DRY & CLEAN**
- Plastic Grocery Bags – Return to your local Grocery store or use our drop off

ITEMS NOT ACCEPTED

- Grass clippings – Leave them on your lawn
- Hard Covered Books
- Smoke Detectors
- Demolition Materials / Construction Debris
- Household Hazardous Waste – Household Hazardous Waste Event HELD IN THE SPRING & FALL – LOOK FOR ADVERTISEMENTS IN THE NEWSPAPER
