

**TOWN OF BETHEL-UTILITIES MAINTAINER** – To perform work daily with the water transmission, distribution, and treatment systems and sewer collection and transmission systems; to maintain water meters, hydrants, valves and appurtenances; to maintain, operate and adjust the water and sewer controls systems and equipment including pumps, motors, chemical feed and automated control systems.
