

INVITATION TO BID

Sealed bids for the **Briar Cliff Water Booster Pump Station and Water Main Extension, Bethel, Connecticut** will be received by the Town of Bethel, Public Works Department at the Clifford J. Hurgin Municipal Center, 1 School Street, Bethel, CT, 06801 until 1:00 P.M., local time, July 18, 2017 and then at said office publicly opened and read aloud. Bids submitted after this time will not be accepted. Each bidder must submit a single sealed envelope, the outside of which must be clearly marked "Briar Cliff Water Booster Pump Station and Water Main Extension". The sealed Bids will be safeguarded until public opening.

The Work involves construction and installation of a new water booster pump station, including electrical, mechanical, instrumentation, connection to existing water distribution system, and installation of a water main extension. This project includes American Iron and Steel Requirements. The Contract Documents may be examined at the following location:

Partial sets will not be distributed. Bidders will be furnished one PDF set of Bidding Documents. No deposit is required for the first download of PDF format Bidding Documents. Additional paper sets may be purchased. No refunds will be given for the return of additional paper sets purchased by bidders. To be considered a responsive Bidder, the Contractor shall have obtained at least one set of Bidding Documents from the Issuing Office (via the Wright-Pierce Online Plan Room). The Bid will not be awarded to a Bidder unless a record for obtaining at least one set of Bidding Documents exists in the Issuing Office. To meet this requirement and to establish the record of receipt, a prospective Bidder must obtain Bidding Documents using the name that is to appear on the Bid Form. A mandatory pre-bid conference will be held at Clifford J. Hurgin Municipal Center, Public Works Department, 1 School Street, Bethel, CT, 06801 on July 6, 2017 at 10 A.M. Attendance is mandatory and participation is encouraged.

The Board of Selectman upon recommendation of the Procurement Committee reserves the right to accept and/or reject any portion of said bid; to waive any technicality in any bid or part thereof and to accept any bid as provided for in Section 8-13c of the Charter of the Town of Bethel.
