



## **Public Informational Meeting**

Town of Bethel, CONNECTICUT - the TOWN of BETHEL has a project for the Intersection Improvements of Walnut Hill Road at Hoyt Road in the Town of Bethel. Preliminary design has been completed and the project is slated for construction under the Local Road Accident Reduction Program administered by the Connecticut Department of Transportation.

It is the Town's and the State's policy to keep persons informed and involved when such projects are undertaken. It is important that the community share its concerns to assist in the project's development. The Town of Bethel will conduct an informational meeting on October 7, 2014 from 6 PM to 9 PM in the General Purpose Room of the Clifford J. Hurgin Municipal Center, 1 School Street, Bethel, Connecticut.

It is planned to reconstruct a portion of Walnut Hill Road and Hoyt Road at the intersection of the roads, including drainage improvements, slope construction and stabilization, paving, curbing, new signage and striping.

Based upon a preliminary assessment, the construction cost will be approximately \$535,000.

The Federal Highway Administration will provide 90% of the construction cost with the Town of Bethel providing 10%.
